
☐ A 4 months old neonate, only 6 kg, was presented with the complaints of:

#### ENDOSCOPIC PROCEDURE REPORT









Procedure: UPPER GI Endoscopy

Indication: Foreign body ingestion

Medication: Ini. Midazolam I/V Slowly

#### FINDINGS:

A foreign body (toy switch ) was found stucked in the middle part of esophagus. Deep ulceration & mucosal inflammation was seen at that region. During intervension it was removed by using rat tooth

. Stomach: Normal findings . Duodenum: Not seen.


